



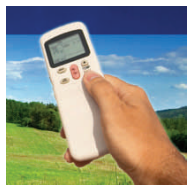

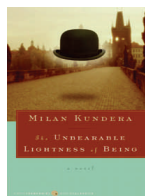
Jim Shuda from Lake Country Heating and Cooling will present information about geothermal and solar heating and cooling for your home, and answer your questions.

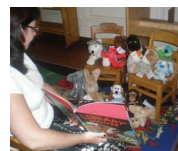

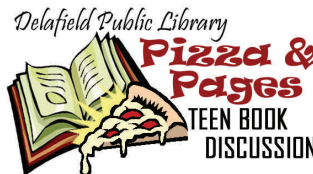
## STUFFED ANIMAL SLEEPOVER!
