

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Which devices are compatible?

Almost all devices are now compatible. For a full list, see <http://www.overdrive.com/resources/drc/>

### How many books can I check out at once?

Six items can be checked out and five items can be on hold.

### How long is the lending period?

The default is set at 7 days but you may be able to choose up to 14 days in your account settings.

### What happens when that time is up?

When the lending period is through, the eBook link will expire. You do not need to electronically return the book.

### Can I renew items?

There is not a renewal function, but if the item has no holds you can simply check it out again.

### Can I use OverDrive for Kindle on the library's public access computers?

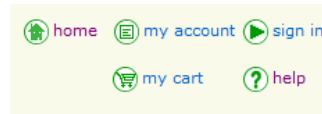

### What do I need?

To download titles you will need

- ◆ Computer with Internet access
- ◆ Amazon.com account

# Downloading Kindle eBooks

## FINDING BOOKS

### 1. Search

- ◆ Use the “Quick Search” bar on the left side of the screen and look for Kindle books
- ◆ or choose “Advanced Search” and select "Kindle Book" as drop down Format

## PLEASE NOTE...

- ◆ Books that say “Place a Hold” are NOT currently available for download
- ◆ Books that say “Add to My Cart” ARE currently available for download
- ◆ Note the option to check “Only show titles with copies available” box

## CHECKING OUT eBooks

### 1. When you find a book...

Select “Add to My Cart.” Items will remain in your cart for 30 minutes. When you finish browsing, select “Proceed to Checkout.”

### 2. Sign in

Choose “Waukesha County Federated Library System” as your library system and enter your full library card number as it appears on the back of your library card. Enter all the letters and numbers with no spaces.

### 3. Check out

Choose lending period, if possible (7 or 14 days). Click “Confirm check out” then “Get for Kindle”

### 4. Amazon.com

You will be taken directly to Amazon.com. Select "Get Library Book" and sign in using your Amazon.com account.

## IF YOUR KINDLE HAS WI-FI

Choose your device and select "Continue." The book will be automatically sent to your device and you are ready to read!

## IF YOUR KINDLE DOES NOT HAVE WI-FI

If you have only 3G on your Kindle, you will need to download the book to your computer and then transfer it via USB cable.

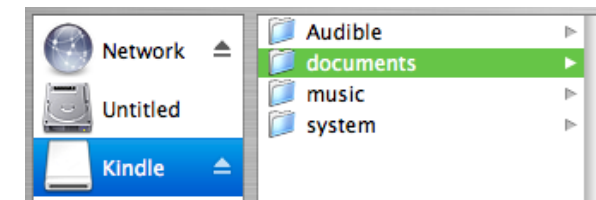

### 1. From Amazon.com

Choose your device and select "Continue." You will be given the option to "Download Now"

### 2. Connect Kindle to your computer

Find the downloaded file and drag it into the "documents" folder of your Kindle. Disconnect and you are ready to read!
