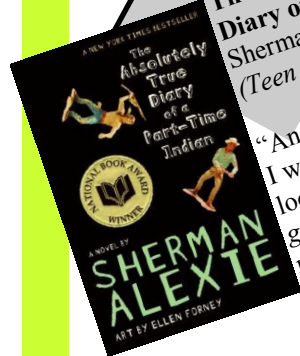


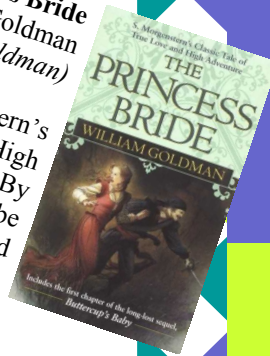

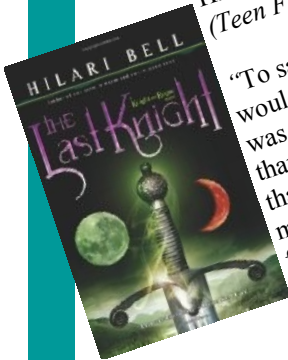

(Teen Fic Bell Bk. 1)



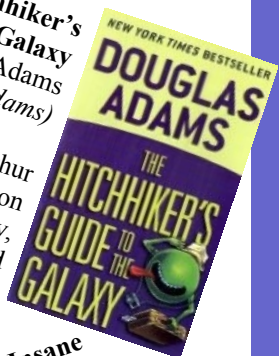

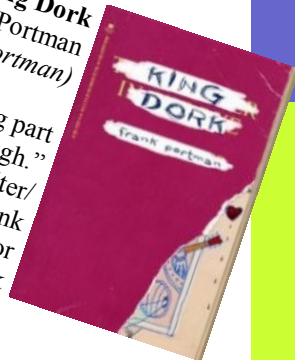
